



Brillman Mentorship in Family Medicine Award

This award recognizes the contributions of faculty and community preceptors who nurture and sustain student interest in Family Medicine through their roles as clinicians, educators or researchers and meet the following criteria:

1. Demonstrates ongoing and consistent commitment to medical student education
2. Espouses the values of Family Medicine
3. Demonstrates excellence in direct student teaching or mentorship as indicated by one or more of the following: outstanding teaching evaluations, significant impact on students, curriculum development activities, academic leadership accomplishments, other contributions.
4. Maintains qualifications as a faculty or adjunct faculty in good standing in the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health (DFMCH) at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health (UW SMPH)
5. Maintains high levels of professional behavior

Requirements for selection include:

1. Completion and submission of application including **personal statement** and **CV**
2. **Two letters** of support specifically addressing applicant's demonstrated influence as a mentor to students in Family Medicine. Letters are to be submitted from:
 - a. Student
 - b. Course or program director familiar with nominee's work with students
3. Review and approval of application by the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health's Director of Medical Student Education

Two Brillman Mentorship in Family Medicine Awards in the amount of \$500.00 each are awarded annually.

Awardees include: tenure track, CHS track, or clinician-teacher track faculty member from the DFMCH, and one community-based adjunct faculty member from the DFMCH.
