He has received NIH funding to study the 'clinician effect' and to incorporate healing modalities into medical school curricula. In 2016 Dr. Rakel moved to Albuquerque, where he was the Professor and Chair of the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of New Mexico School of Medicine.
